Leonardo was born in 1452 in the small village of Vinci in Italy. From an early age he showed an extraordinary talent for music and mathematics. He was a painter, a sculptor, an inventor, an engineer and an architect. He spent a lot of time studying science, human anatomy and physiology. He could play musical instruments and sing. Leonardo loved playing jokes and tricks on people.

In those days, Italy was a collection of independent city states, and artists depended on finding a rich and powerful patron. Leonardo travelled a lot during his lifetime. The Duke of Milan was a good master and appreciated his talents, but after his fall Leonardo wasn't able to stay in Milan because it was too dangerous. He returned to Florence, where he met his great rival Michelangelo. Even though they shared much in common, they couldn't stand each other. Later on he worked for the Pope in Rome. Leonardo left Italy in 1516 and went to France. He stayed at the court of Francis I. The young king loved and respected him. According to legend, the artist died in the monarch's arms three years later.

Leonardo had other peculiar talents – he could write or paint equally well with either hand, and he was able to write in mirrorwriting very well. Unusually for the age, he was a vegetarian.
